### Dear Family and Friends,

This is my first official newsletter to keep everyone informed about your new appointed Missionary from Whitley Church. I am currently serving in the Short Term Overseas Workers Program of the IPHC World Missions Ministries. I have been assigned to the Dominican Republic working under the supervision of career Missionaries Darrel and Bonnie Clowers. My duties will be to assist in the creation of The Carpenter's House. The Carpenter's House is a shop where I will teach and train wood crafting skills to people in economically suppressed areas of the Caribbean. The purpose of the shop is to help advance and fund church planting and elevate economically the influence of Believers. The Carpenter's House is one of many projects associated with the People to People Ministries of WMM. The Carpenter's House is a new micro-business which will help people to establish commercial skills in their community. Commerce is essential for the long-term stability and health of a community. In April I set into motion the first steps to create our first shop in Santo Domingo, DR and in August I will be returning to the DR for the completion of this shop. In September we will go into Haiti to see about possibly setting up a new one there by the end of this year.
